Ginji

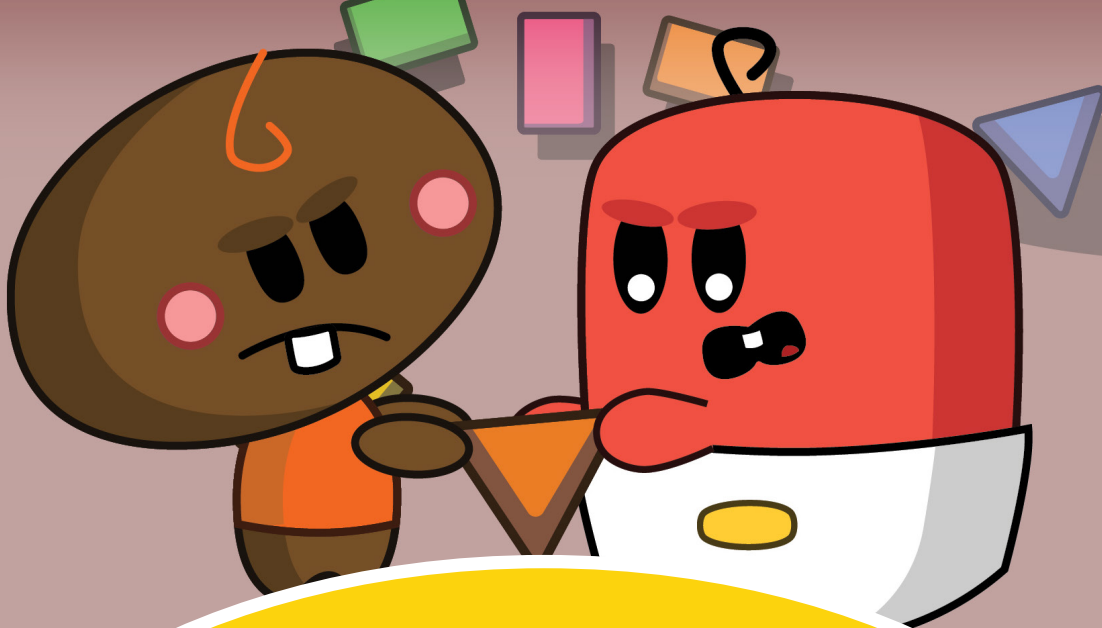


Rachel

one Ting,” Ginji said angrily.

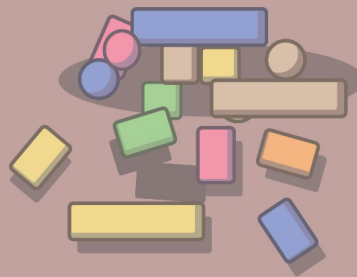
“It is an important piece for my
